Definition of an Operative Procedure:

A. Occurs during a single trip to the Operating Room (may include C-section room, interventional radiology room or cardiac catheterization lab that meet FGI/AIA OR criteria), *and*

B. Surgeon makes at least one incision through the skin or mucous membrane, including laparoscopic approach, and closes the incision primarily before the patient leaves the OR room, *and*

C. The procedure is assigned by ICD-9-CM codes to one of the categories listed below.
