Current Status of Vaccine Data:

- Pfizer (mRNA, 2 doses, administered 21 days apart)
 - Authorized for emergency use: 12/11/2020.
 - o Cold chain requirements: -75 degrees Celsius, good under refrigeration for 5 days.
 - o <u>Pfizer</u> and <u>FDA</u> guidance documents.
 - Fact sheet for providers and recipients.
 - The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) released a summary of key
 <u>recommendations</u> pertaining to COVID-19 vaccination amongst those who may become pregnant,
 are pregnant, or are breast feeding.
- Moderna (mRNA, 2 doses, administered 28 days apart)
 - Authorized for emergency use: 12/18/20.
 - Cold chain requirements: -20 degrees Celsius, good under refrigeration for 30 days.
 - Moderna and FDA guidance documents.
 - Fact sheets for <u>providers</u> and <u>recipients</u>.
- Astra Zeneca (adenovirus vector vaccine, initially studied as 2 doses)
 - Pending FDA approval.





- Johnson & Johnson (adenovirus vector vaccine, initially studied as 1 dose)
 - Pending FDA approval (approximately February 2021).

FDA:

- The FDA posted the <u>review memorandum</u> outlining the basis of the agency's decision to authorize the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.
- The FDA authorized the first COVID-19 diagnostic test for self-testing at home.
- Emergency Use Authorization for Vaccines Explained.

USP updated operational considerations for sterile compounding during the COVID-19 pandemic.

TJC:

 <u>The Joint Commission 2021 National Patient Safety Goals</u> for hospital programs go into effect January 1, 2021.

Hospital Safety Scores:

The Leapfrog Group <u>released</u> its fall 2020 Hospital Safety Grades, assigning "A" through "F" letter grades to more than 2,600 acute care hospitals for patient safety performance. The data for this safety grades update does not yet include hospitals' performance during the height of COVID-19. This spring's update will be the first to incorporate pandemic response periods.
