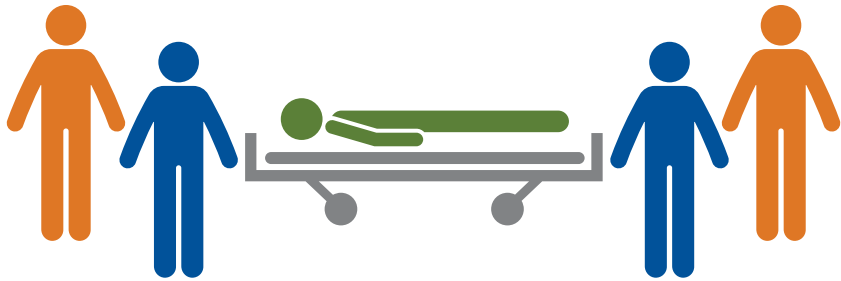





DUHS Inmate/Patient and Guard PPE Guidelines

Transport Guidelines



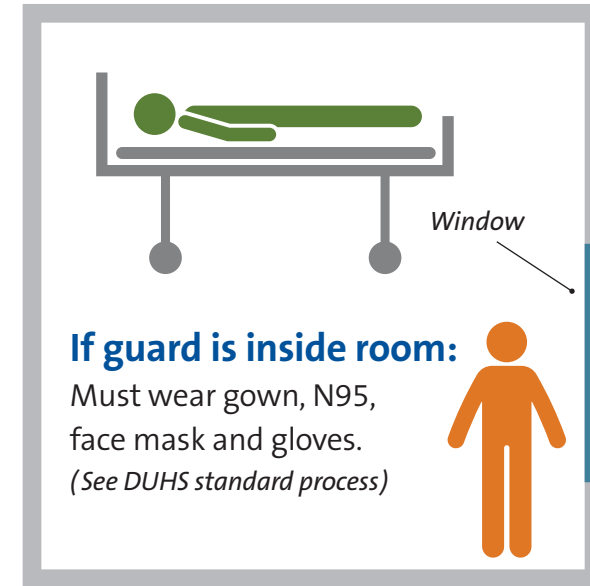
-  **Guard:** Surgical or procedural mask
-  **Healthcare worker:** DUHS standard process
-  **Inmate/patient:** Surgical mask

In-Room Guidelines (Without window)



Guard inside room:
Must wear gown, N95,
face mask and gloves.
(See DUHS standard process)

In-Room Guidelines (With window)



If guard is inside room:
Must wear gown, N95,
face mask and gloves.
(See DUHS standard process)

If guard is outside room:
Must wear surgical
mask at all times.
Stay by room with
visual through
window; no travel.

If healthcare worker goes into room, guard must accompany.

Inmate/patient safety requirements:

- All inmates/patients and prison staff should be considered potentially exposed to COVID-19.
- Inmate/patient must be within visual contact at all times and the weapon must be accessible by guard.
- Guard must accompany inmate/patient to any location. (Exception: in OR under anesthesia).
- All PPE guidelines must be followed 100% of the time (N95 mask requires clean-shaven face). Guards need surgical mask at minimum at all times on site.
- Healthcare worker PPE guidelines: DUHS standard process.
